

Dean's Club Levels

 **WASHINGTON F. PECK LEVEL: \$10,000 and above**

Washington F. Peck was the first dean of the University of Iowa Roy J. and Lucille A. Carver College of Medicine and was acknowledged as the driving force behind the new medical school. He served the college for 21 years.

 **ELIZABETH HESS LEVEL: \$5,000 to \$9,999**

The University of Iowa Roy J. and Lucille A. Carver College of Medicine was the first medical school in the nation to include men and women in medical classes together. Elizabeth Hess was among the earliest women students. She earned her medical degree from the UI in 1874 and practiced in the Iowa City area for more than 20 years. Her knowledge of medicine and concern for others earned the respect of her fellow physicians and her patients as she cleared a path for women who followed.

 **OLD SOUTH HALL LEVEL: \$2,500 to \$4,999**

Old South Hall, located on what is now the campus Pentacrest, housed classes for the college from the time the program started until 1883, when a new medical building became the home for the thriving medical college.

 **DEAN'S CLUB: \$1,000 to \$2,499 (and all higher levels)**
