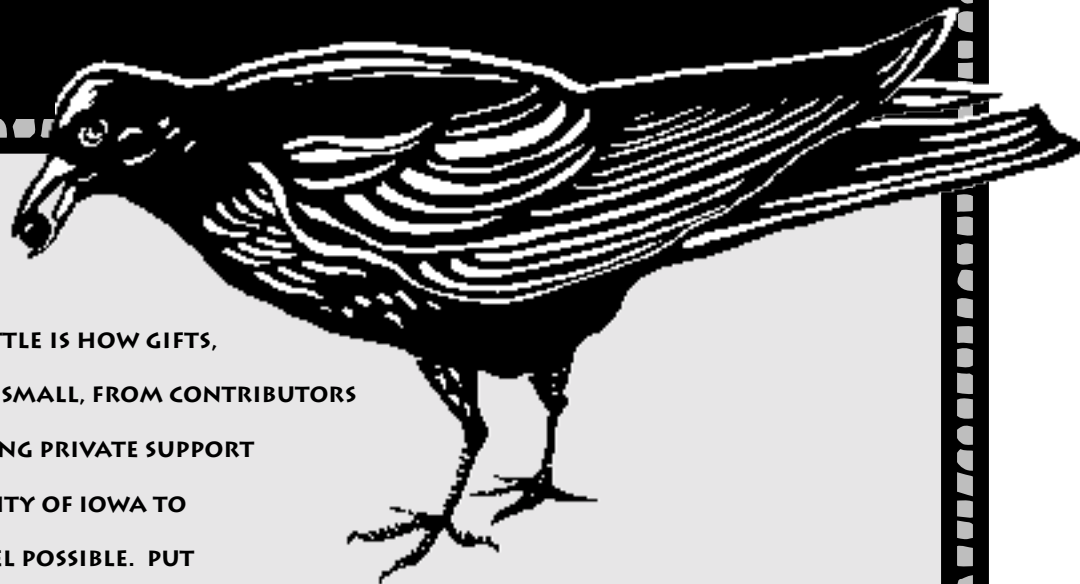




A CROW SUFFERING FROM THIRST SAW A PITCHER,
